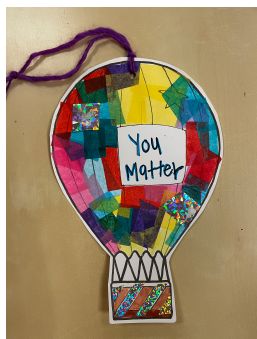
Print Your Own Trading Card

Inspired by the current AVAM exhibition "Good Sports," students will print their own trading card using a stamp, and decorate with collage and other visionary supplies. Recommended for grades 8 and up.



Memory Sculpture

Inspired by artist Judith Scott's fiber artworks, students will use foil, yarn and fabric to create a sculpture that represents a memory. Recommended for grades 6 and up.



Leonard Knight's Love Balloon Collage

Artist Leonard Knight spent 10 years creating his hot air balloon in order to spread the religious message "God is Love." In this workshop, students will create their own hot air balloon using tissue paper, glue and bling. Let's spread positivity through art! Recommended for all ages.



Esther Krinitz Story Cloth

Esther Krinitz's hand sewn tapestries depict her memories of survival during the Nazi invasion of Poland in the midst of The Holocaust. In this workshop, students will be asked to create their own story in fabric, no sewing required. Recommended for grades 6 and up.



Imagination Portraits

Artist Gregory Warmack, aka "Mr. Imagination," turned paint brushes into personalities. Let's do the same! Each student will get one paintbrush, Apoxie sculpt, and baubles to apply as decoration. This is a messy project. Recommended for grades 3-8.
